I have owned and sold sheds out of this property in question since 1998.

Originally the building inspector at the time issued us a permit to be there, permit to tear the existing building down, and install a sign .

For whatever reason I can only find the sign permit.

The town cannot find any documents.

I have operated and improved the location including a new garage since 1998.

The only thing I want to do different is add a small office for two employees and a single bathroom .

I have met customers, showed customers around and made sales from this location since 1998.

I also have made sales and met customers at my rt 22 lot as well.

The site has artesian well and a new septic field that was installed for the existing dinner before it closed.

There has never been a shed limitation at either location,

We usually fill the shed s up to capacity early spring for the upcoming season.

There has never been an hour restriction at either location.

I have never had a complaint at either location.

Lighting will stay the same with one existing outside pole light which has been there since 1998.

The only stipulation Dene Herrick and Kent Pratt (the previous inspector and then deputy inspector) stated was that buildings placed near the creek be tied down should there be a flood.

The new office is approx. 227 ' from the creek.
