Thank you for your correspondence to the New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT), dated September 1, 2022, requesting lower maximum speed limits on the following roads:

- Main Street (all) – Town of New Lebanon
- Extension Street (all) – Town of New Lebanon

The speed limit on Main Street is now 30 MPH (1110.20 (r)).

A review of Extension Street revealed conditions that do not support a lower maximum speed limit.

Since Main Street is a Town owned and operated roadway, it is the responsibility of the Town to install and maintain the proper speed limit signage in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) and the New York State Supplement to the MUTCD. These roadways should also be reviewed by the Town to determine if certain conditions may require the posting of additional warning signs.

New York State Police (Troop K), Columbia County Sheriff's Department and the Town of New Lebanon will be notified of the lower maximum speed limit request approval and denial by copy of this letter.
