INTRODUCTORY LOCAL LAW NO. 4 OF THE YEAR 2023

A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND CHAPTER 145 OF THE TOWN CODE OF THE TOWN OF NEW LEBANON

SECTION 1

This local law shall be referred to as "A Local Law to Amend Chapter 145 of the Town Code of the Town of New Lebanon".

SECTION 2

Chapter 145 of the Town Code of the Town of New Lebanon is hereby amended as follows:

A. Section 145-2 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

§ 145-2. Statement of purpose.

The purpose of this chapter is to provide rules and standards for the operation and licensing of existing and future mobile home parks in order to protect the health, safety and general welfare of residents of the town where mobile home parks are permissible.

B. Section 145-3 is hereby amended to add the following definition of term in appropriate alphabetical order:

COMPACT HOME

A compact home, as defined in Section 205-20 of Chapter 205, Zoning, of the Code of the Town of New Lebanon.

C. Section 145-3 is hereby amended to modify the definitions of "Home", "Mobile Home Accessory Building or Structure", "Mobile Home Park" and "Mobile Home Site" to read as set forth below:

HOME

A mobile home, manufactured home, or compact home in a mobile home park.

MOBILE HOME ACCESSORY BUILDING OR STRUCTURE

A building or structure which is in addition to or supplements the facilities provided for a mobile home, manufactured home, or compact home. It is not a self-contained, separate and habitable building or structure.

MOBILE HOME PARK (hereafter known as "park")

A property consisting of a tract of land maintained by an operator for two or more mobile homes, compact homes, and/or manufactured homes, which may be occupied by persons for residential purposes other than recreation, traveling or vacationing, and who are provided services or facilities necessary for their use of the property.

MOBILE HOME SITE (hereinafter also known as "site")

A designated parcel of land in a mobile home park provided by the operator and designed for accommodating one mobile home, compact home, or manufactured home, its accessory buildings or structures, and accessory equipment for the exclusive use of the occupants.

D. Section 145-4 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

§ 145-4. Applicability.

The requirements of this chapter shall apply to a mobile home park maintained for the placement of two or more mobile homes, compact homes, and/or manufactured homes. Unless otherwise specified, the requirements of this chapter apply to both existing and new mobile home parks.

E. Paragraph A of Section 145-5 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

A. Setbacks from public schools and public parkland. Any property line of a mobile home park shall be at least 1,000 feet from the property line of property used for public school purposes or for public parkland.

F. A new Paragraph N is hereby added to Section 145-5 to read in its entirety as follows:

N. Compliance with Zoning. Mobile home parks shall comply with all applicable provisions of Chapter 205, Zoning, of the Code of the Town of New Lebanon, including without limitation, Schedule 1,

Area and Bulk Regulations, and Schedule 2, Zoning Law Use Table, except where a provision of Chapter 205 directly conflicts with a provision of this chapter, in which case, this chapter shall control.

SECTION 3

If any word, phrase, sentence, part, section, subsection, or other portion of this Law or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is declared void, unconstitutional, or invalid for any reason, then such word, phrase, sentence, part, section, subsection, or other portion, or the proscribed application thereof, shall be severable, and the remaining provisions of this Law, and all applications thereof, not having been declared void, unconstitutional, or invalid, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4

This Local Law is enacted pursuant to the New York Municipal Home Rule Law.

SECTION 5

This Law shall become effective upon filing with the New York Secretary of State.
